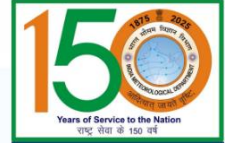

Sub: Heavy to very heavy rainfall likely over Odisha due to the Low Pressure area over Gangetic West Bengal and adjoining Jharkhand & north Odisha.

Current Meteorological Features

❖ The Low Pressure area over North Odisha and adjoining Jharkhand & Gangetic West Bengal now lies over Gangetic West Bengal and adjoining Jharkhand & north Odisha at 0830 hrs IST of today, 17th July, 2026. The associated cyclonic circulation now extends upto 5.8 km above mean sea level tilting southwestwards with height. It is very likely to weaken gradually during next 24 hrs.

❖ The Monsoon trough at mean sea level now passes through Amritsar, Chandigarh, Shahjahanpur, Basti, Patna, centre of Low Pressure area over Gangetic West Bengal and adjoining Jharkhand & north Odisha and thence southeastwards towards Northeast Bay of Bengal and extends upto 0.9 km above mean sea level.

YELLOW WARNING:- (BE AWARE) Isolated Heavy Rainfall very likely to occur at one or two places over the districts of Mayurbhanj, Keonjhar, Sundargarh, Jharsuguda, Sambalpur, Deogarh, Angul, Kalahandi, Kandhamal, Nawarangpur, and Nuapada.
Day 2 (Valid from 0830 hrs IST of 18.07.2026 to 0830 hrs IST of 19.07.2026)	YELLOW WARNING:- (BE AWARE) Heavy Rainfall very likely to occur at one or two places over the districts of Mayurbhanj, Keonjhar, Sundargarh, Bargarh, Bolangir, and Nuapada.
Day 3 (Valid from 0830 hrs IST of 19.07.2026 to 0830 hrs IST of 20.07.2026)	YELLOW WARNING:- (BE AWARE) Heavy Rainfall very likely to occur at one or two places over the districts of Mayurbhanj and Keonjhar.
Day 4 (Valid from 0830 hrs IST of 20.07.2026 to 0830 hrs IST of 21.07.2026)	YELLOW WARNING:- (BE AWARE) Heavy Rainfall very likely to occur at one or two places over the districts of Mayurbhanj, Keonjhar, Jharsuguda and Sundargarh.

Sea condition:-

Sea condition is very likely to be rough to very rough along and off Odisha coast on 17th July 2026.

Fishermen Warning:

Fishermen are advised not to venture into along & off Odisha coasts on 17th July 2026.

Port Warning Signals :

Lower Local Cautionary Signal No-III (LC-3) at all ports of Odisha.

Impacts & actions suggested

Districts	Impact	Actions
Bargarh, Bolangir, Sonepur and Boudh	• Localized Flooding of roads, water logging in low lying areas and closure of underpasses mainly in urban areas. • Occasional reduction in visibility due to heavy rainfall. • Disruption of traffic in major cities due to water logging in roads leading to increased travel time. • Minor damage to kutchha roads. • Possibilities of damage to vulnerable structure. • Landslides/Mudslides/landslips/mudslips/landsinks/mudsinks. • Damage to horticulture and standing crops in some areas due to inundation. • It may lead to riverine flooding in some river catchments (for riverine flooding please visit Web page of CWC).	• Check for traffic congestion on your route before leaving for your destination. • Follow any traffic advisories that are issued in this regard. • Avoid going to areas that face the water logging problems often. • Avoid staying in vulnerable structure.

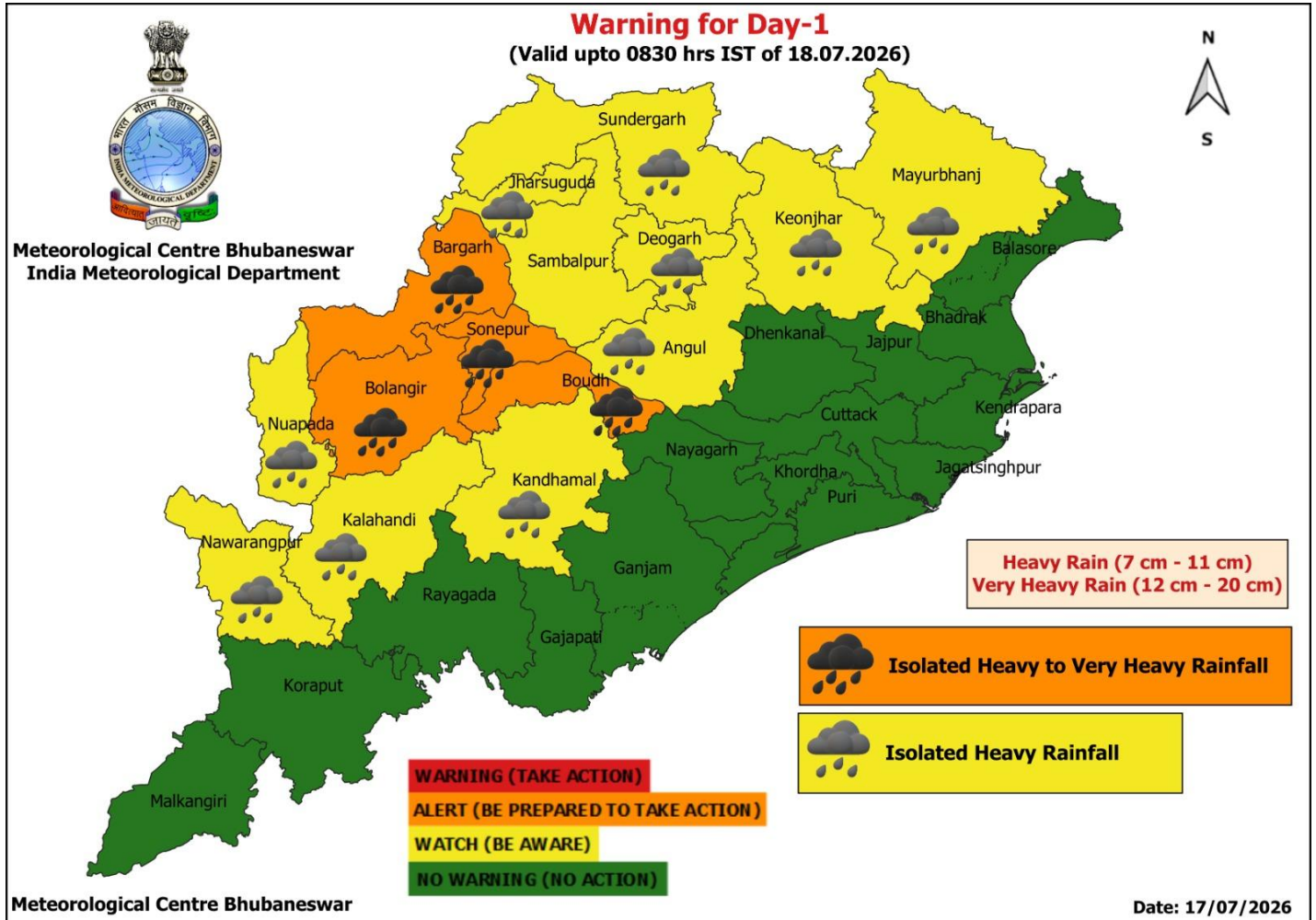

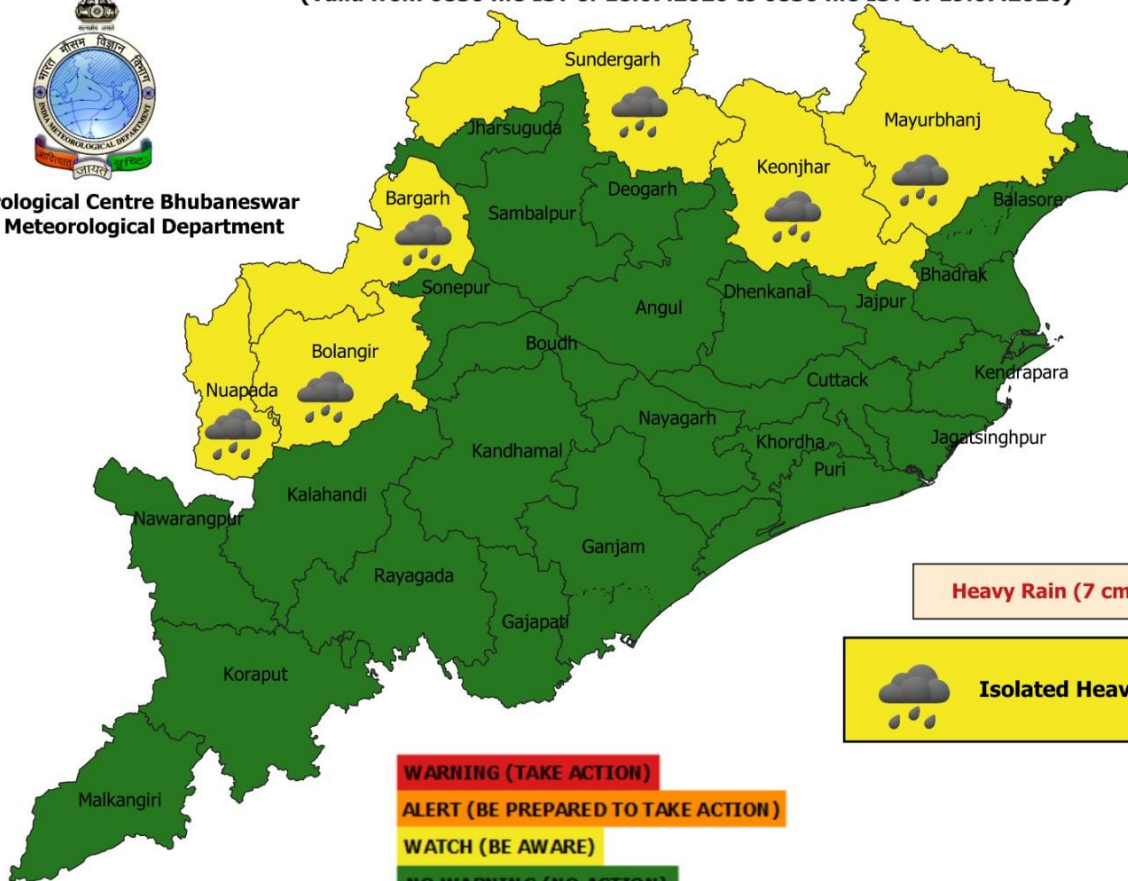

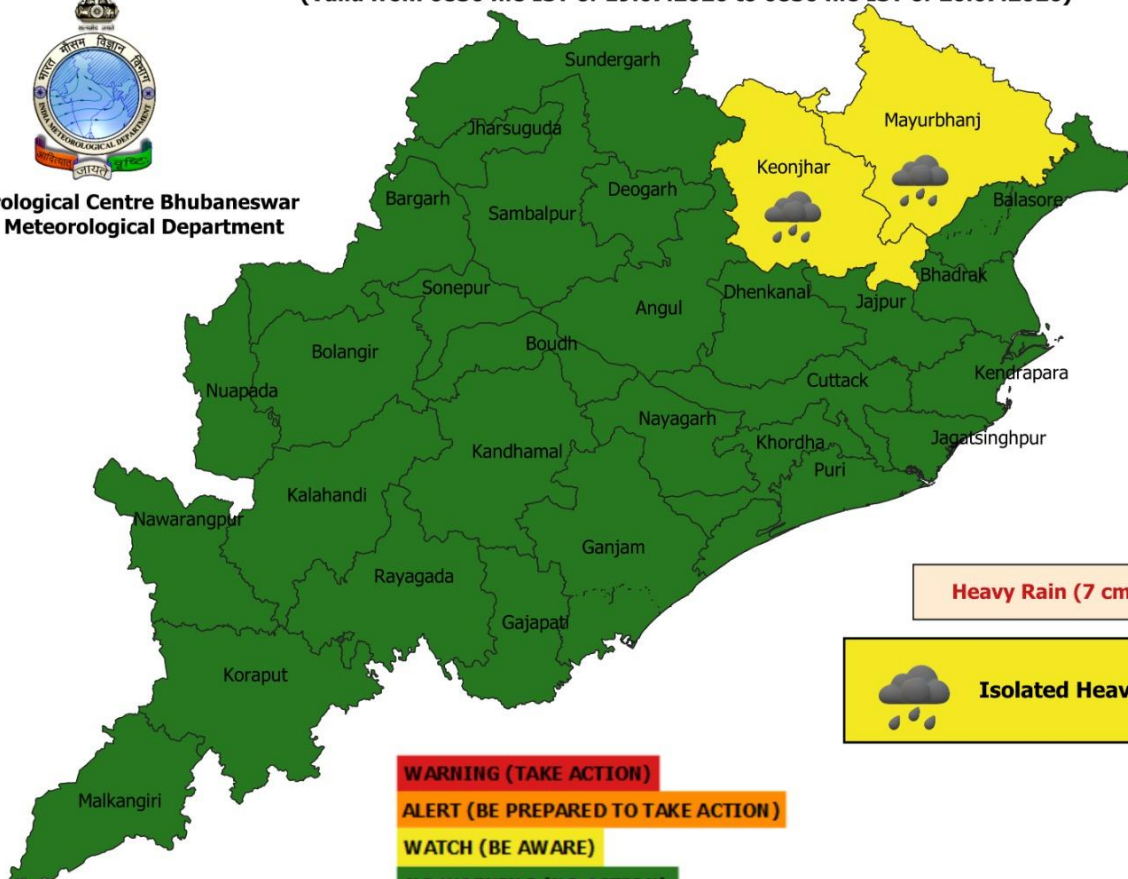
